The Adult Nurse Assistant program offered by the Capital Region BOCES Career & Technical School, Health Careers Center, is a great starting place for individuals who would like to work as a supportive caregiver in a health care setting or pursue further education in Practical Nursing or other health-related disciplines. Students learn total patient care in both the classroom and through off-campus, supervised clinical experiences. Students prepare for the New York State Certified Nurse Assistant examination. Such certification qualifies them to work in any nursing home in the state.



PREADMISSION REQUIREMENTS:

- Minimum age: 17

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS:

- Successful interview
- Professional and personal references
- Physical exam and immunizations
- Each NA candidate must have a volunteer patient on the day of the state test

FULL-TIME PROGRAM:

- Length: 5 weeks
- Hours: 8:30 a.m. - 3 p.m., Mon.- Fri.

PART-TIME EVENING PROGRAM:

- Length: 8 weeks
- Hours: 3 - 7 p.m., Mon. - Fri.

- Application fee: \$25
- Commitment fee: \$100 upon acceptance (nonrefundable; credited toward tuition)
- Tuition: \$1,400
